DESCRIPTION

LET YOURSELF BE INSPIRED BY NATURE

The trail leads directly to punta Crucitta and its bay. Just like trail no. 12 [see description], it starts at the foot of Arbuticci fortress, by entering the mule track further north, which slopes downhill.

Leaving the ilex grove behind, the mule track turns into a narrow trail, surrounded by tall and thick Myrtles and Heather.

Where the vegetation starts thinning out, continue straight following the signs to Cala Crucitta, for a short but rough uphill walk; once at the summit you find few small military posts, embedded in the rocks, which offer a magnificent panoramic viewpoint to observe the pathway from the top.

Once over the top, spectacular view enables you to catch a glimpse of the many coves and granitic inlets and the massive Corsica Mountains stand out in the sea with its myriads of shades of blue.

Proceed downhill, at the second crossroad, following the signs to the left toward Punta Crucitta, take the slightly winding stony trail, that leads straight down to the bay, with

worth exploring, continuing northbound, the northernmost point of the island of Caprera, Punta Galera.

You may return going through Cala Napoletana, following the signs for trail no.14.
